Tuesday 5th July 2016

Arrive into Belfast International Airport

GOLF : Free day - sightseeing day (golf available if desired)
HOTEL : Merchant Hotel, Belfast (3 nights, July 5-7, 2016)



Belfast's only AA 5 Star Rated Hotel, The Merchant Hotel is located in the heart of the Cathedral Quarter, surrounded by some of Belfast's best bars and restaurants and close to the city's shopping areas and transport links. From the grandeur of the Great Room Restaurant to the pure indulgence of the roof top hot tub; from the sumptuous Victorian style bedrooms to the sleek Art Deco events floor; every element of the hotel is presented to the highest of standards. Since its opening the hotel has been honoured with over 100 accolades including, AA Hotel of the Year and Tales of The Cocktail's World's Best Cocktail Bar.

GOLF : Royal Belfast Golf Club

Founded in 1881, Royal Belfast Golf Club lays claim to the title of the oldest golf course in Ireland. The present course dates back to 1925, when responsibility for the course design was given to H.S. Colt, the eminent English course architect of the day. With the assistance of Walker Cup player W.A. Murray, Colt produced a course of great charm which provides a true test of golfing skill and enjoys one of the most scenic settings of any in the British Isles with its unrivalled views of Belfast Lough and the Antrim plateau beyond. The course is a tribute to the enduring excellence of its original design, always meticulously maintained with impeccable greens, groves of rhododendrons and gorse providing a colorful backdrop in spring.

GOLF : Royal Portrush Golf Club (World # 14 course)

Royal Portrush Golf Club is home to one of the best and most challenging links golf courses in the world, the Dunluce Links, and the hidden gem, the Valley Links. The only club in Ireland to have hosted The Open Championship, and more than fifty national championships, Royal Portrush is situated on the beautiful North Antrim Causeway coast, boasting magnificent views of the hills of Donegal in the west, the Isle of Islay and Southern Hebrides in the north, and the Giant's Causeway and the Skerries in the east. The course is overlooked by the ruins of 13th century Dunluce Castle giving rise to the name of the famous Dunluce course.

HOTEL : Merchant Hotel, Belfast

Friday 8th July 2016

GOLF : Royal County Down Golf Club (World # 5 course)

Royal County Down is one of the oldest Golf Clubs in Ireland with traditions dating back for more than one hundred years. Situated in Newcastle, where in the immortal words of Percy French, "The Mountains of Mourne sweep down to the sea", Royal County Down is not only a fine test of golf but has accompanying scenery that is spellbinding. The narrowest ribbons of fairways thread their way through as impressive a set of sand dunes as could be imagined. The fairways are surrounded by purple heather and golden gorse, so beautiful to look at but so punishing for any who may stray from the prescribed path. The 'bearded' bunkers are world famous and feature overhanging lips of marram, red fescue and heather.

HOTEL : Dylan Hotel, Ballsbridge, Dublin 4 (2 nights, July 8-10, 2016)



The Dylan Hotel resonates style and luxury in Ireland's most dynamic and sophisticated city. Dylan has 44 bedrooms with luxuries such as Frette linen, in-room safe, twice-daily room styling, marble bathrooms, robe and slippers, and much more. The Dylan's Victorian façade belies the pulse that beats within. By day, the open-plan lobby exudes warmth, elegance, tranquility – an oasis amid the hustle and bustle of Dublin. By night, it takes on the heady glow of candles and champagne. Overall, Dylan is bright and vibrant, characteristics which sing throughout its design & style and the responsive, personality-driven team.

Saturday 9th July 2016

GOLF : Portmarnock Golf Club (World # 46 course)

Universally acknowledged as one of the truly great links, Portmarnock is situated to the north side of Dublin, about 12 miles from the city centre. Its quality and location have made it a splendid venue for some of the game's great events, from the British Amateur Championship of 1949, to the Canada Cup in 1960, the 1991 Walker Cup and 12 stagings of the revived Irish Open. In 1901 Portmarnock hosted the inaugural Irish Ladies Championship and in 1931 the British Ladies Championship for the first time on Irish soil. Martin Hawtree, whose father had designed the third nine 34 years previously, was commissioned to change and upgrade the course, prior to the 2003 Irish Open. effectively lengthening it to 7,466 yards

HOTEL : Dylan Hotel, Ballsbridge, Dublin 4

Sunday 10th July 2016

GOLF : Transfer day - afternoon game at Doonbeg

'The Doonbeg' as it is known, officially opened in 2002, by its designer and two-time Open Champion, Greg Norman. It was his first venture into true links terrain and is a stunning conquest. In late 2014 Doonbeg was purchased by Donald Trump. The luxury golf resort has since been renamed Trump International Golf Links & Hotel Ireland. The course spans 1.5 miles of crescent shaped beach and century old sand dunes along Doughmore Bay. The par-72 layout features a single loop of nine holes out and nine back. In line with Norman's philosophy of 'least disturbance', the most natural route was taken in laying the course out through the sand dunes. As a result, the course has a unique combination of five par 3s and five par 5s.

HOTEL: Trump International at Doonbeg, Doonbeg, Co Clare (2 nights, July 10-12, 2016)



Accommodations at Trump International at Doonbeg are extraordinary. The suites are private residences, designed to be guests' home away from home. They are equipped with everything a discriminating traveler would require. Suites average 2,000 sq.ft and cottages average 3,000 sq.ft, individually designed and decorated so that no two are alike. Each consists of a living room with fireplace, fully equipped kitchen, and differing number of bedrooms. Guests also enjoy the many amenities of the Lodge, including preferred tee times, 5-star dining, spa, pub, golf shop, and concierge service.

Monday 11th July 2016

GOLF : Lahinch Golf Club (World # 42 course)

Founded in 1893 by a Scottish Regiment of British Army officers stationed in Limerick, Lahinch Golf Club with its towering sand dunes, undulating fairways and rolling greens is the perfect example of a true Irish links. Located on the edge of the village, Lahinch is known as the St. Andrew's of Ireland and has been a golfing mecca for over 100 years. The Old Course is a spectacular links and is a product of design originally by Old Tom Morris and, more significantly, in the 1920's by Alistair McKenzie. The Old Course was dramatically modernised and further enhanced by Martin Hawtree in 2003.



The original goats at Lahinch were owned by an old Lahinch caddie, Tommy Walsh, who lived close to the old 3rd tee. Tommy caddied for the great John Ball of Hoylake (Open Champion 1890) when he came to Lahinch in the early 1900's. The goats were a great guide to the weather at Lahinch. If they were seen hovering near the club house the weather prospects were not good. Once the goats made their way to the outer sand hills, weather prospects were good. In the 1960's when the Club Barometer broke down, Secretary at the time, Brud Slattery, put a sign up on the barometer "See Goats".

HOTEL : Trump International at Doonbeg, Doonbeg, Co Clare

Tuesday 12th July 2016

GOLF : Ballybunion Golf Club - Old Course (World # 17 course)

The Old Course at Ballybunion is one of the most popular courses in the whole of Ireland. Established in 1893, the course was extended to 18 holes in 1926. Ballybunion has been recognized around the world as a special place since its foundation in 1893 and the Old Course is now regarded as one of the finest links courses ever built. In 1995 design changes were overseen by Tom Watson and befitting his wonderful work Tom Watson was appointed Millennium Captain in 2000. The Irish Men's and Ladies Amateur Championships have been played on Ballybunion's Old Course on numerous occasions and in recent years it has hosted the Irish Open, the Palmer Cup, and the Irish Seniors Open.

HOTEL : Killarney Plaza Hotel, Killarney, Co Kerry (3 nights, July 12-15, 2016)



Luxury rooms, superb restaurants, bars and a luxury Spa, are all wrapped up in graceful, contemporary decor and delivered with an attentive personal hotel service. The Killarney Plaza and Spa Hotel Ireland has fast established itself as an institution of luxury and quality in a town of unsurpassed natural beauty. Located in the heart of Killarney Town at the gateway to the Ring of Kerry, this beautifully appointed hotel has dozens of great Killarney pubs and restaurants within strolling distance of the front door. Neighbored by the amazing beauty of the Killarney National Park there are a wealth of amenities at your disposal.

Wednesday 13th July 2016

GOLF : Waterville Golf Links (World # 91 course)

Golf at Waterville is a mystical experience, the beauty of classic links land and sea, forever challenged and shaped by the elements. Waterville is currently ranked in the top 3 courses in Ireland and the top 20 links courses in the world. Its Georgian Manor clubhouse sits on a narrow isthmus facing the wild Atlantic with beautiful Lough Currane on its eastern perimeter. Waterville embarked on a new chapter of its fabled history when noted golf architect, Tom Fazio, was commissioned to update the Eddie Hackett masterpiece. Fazio has assisted many of the world's leading clubs including Winged Foot, Pine Valley and Augusta National.

HOTEL: Killarney Plaza Hotel, Killarney, Co Kerry

Thursday 14th July 2016

GOLF : Old Head Golf Links (formerly world top 100)

Unrivalled in terms of the magnificent beauty and setting of the site, Old Head Golf Links of Kinsale continues to take the golfing world by storm. The brainchild of John and Patrick O'Connor, Old Head has developed into one of the most recognized and sought after golf experiences anywhere on earth. The promontory is almost an island with numerous caves running beneath your feet as you play the course. The links and practice area occupy 180 acres and the remaining 40 acres of unspoilt cliff, rising in places to over 300 feet, frame the course. Nine holes play along the cliff tops, and all eighteen holes provide stunning ocean views.

HOTEL: Killarney Plaza Hotel, Killarney, Co Kerry

The hotel's design mixes Victorian architecture, high ceilings, and original brown brick with modern comfort. Murals by local artists line the walls, while the restaurant serves local dishes prepared with fresh, locally sourced ingredients.

Saturday 16th July 2016

GOLF : Attend Day 3 of The Open at Royal Troon Golf Club



Royal Troon will welcome the world's finest golfers to compete in the 145th Open Championship. The Open has a remarkable legacy of inspiring Champions and Royal Troon will be proudly host the Open for a ninth time. Iconic victories such as Arnold Palmer in 1962, Tom Watson's fourth Open in 1982, Mark Calcavecchia's thrilling 3-way playoff win in 1989, and in 2004 Todd Hamilton's play-off victory over Ernie Els.

Royal Troon took its current form in 1888, designed in the traditional out-and-back manner of the Old Course at St Andrews. The opening few holes encourage players into the round whilst the closing hole tempt birdies. Both are bookends for a series of middle holes which weave around, up and through incredibly striking links land which will no doubt thrill players and spectators alike next July.

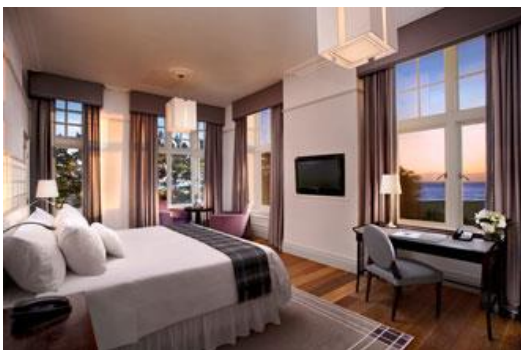
GOLF : Western Gailes Golf Club

tee times TBC



Western Gailes Golf Club, founded in 1897, is situated on the Ayrshire coast of Scotland where many of the finest Scottish golf links are located. It is recognized as one of the finest and true links courses in Scotland. The course presents a fair challenge with very few blind shots. Aside from the strategically placed bunkers, hazards include the beach to the west of the course, the railway line to the east, three burns and a testing breeze off the Firth of Clyde. Western Gailes will be used for final qualifying for the Open at Royal Troon, and has hosted the Curtis Cup and eight Scottish Amateur Championships. 2006 US Open Champion, Australian Geoff Ogilvy has described Western Gailes... "beautiful holes on great land make it endlessly interesting and challenging".

HOTEL: Trump Turnberry Hotel, Turnberry (3 nights, July 18-21, 2016)



Created in the grand style of the early 20th century, Turnberry is surely one of Scotland's national treasures. As you approach the resort, Scotland's glorious west coast gives way to the familiar soft green of the world famous golf courses, swiftly followed by your first glimpse of the unmistakable red roofs of this Edwardian era hotel with the glowering silhouette of Ailsa Craig in the distance. True to its history, the pace of life at Turnberry is unhurried. An extensive renovation program in 2009 has restored the original vision of the hotel, transforming its public rooms and ensuring Turnberry's enduring reputation as one of the world's top hotels.



Tuesday 19th July 2016

GOLF : Prestwick Golf Club (host of first 13 Open Championships) tee times TBC



Prestwick Golf Club is situated just half an hour south west of Glasgow on the famous golfing Ayrshire coast, a stretch of land unequalled anywhere in the world for prime golfing terrain. In 1851 when the Club was founded, two cottages were purchased - the first would become the members' clubhouse whilst the other was gifted to the club's Keeper of the Green, ball and club maker - Old Tom Morris. Together with a gold medal presented by the club's first captain, the Earl of Eglinton, for an annual competition still played for today, the legend of Prestwick was born. 'The fact that Prestwick was the original site for The Open Championship simply confirms the history of the club and its place as one of the best golf experiences in the world'... Ernie Els.

HOTEL : Trump Turnberry Hotel, Turnberry

Wednesday 20th July 2016

GOLF : Ailsa Course, Turnberry (World # 19 course) tee times TBC



Scene of some of the most memorable moments in Open golf history, The Ailsa is a legend in the world game and host to The Open Championship on four occasions. Beloved since its first formal course was built in 1901, Turnberry's fairways have been shared by the game's elite. Even the conversion of its links to runways during two world wars could not diminish the desire to play here, with rolling hills, sandy dunes, and stiff breezes blowing off the Ayrshire coast. Beautiful in sun, exacting in cold and wind, these lands inspire golf and it's that extraordinary experience that keeps golfers returning again and again.

HOTEL : Trump Turnberry Hotel, Turnberry

Deposit Requirements

First Deposit:

A non-refundable deposit of AUD\$3,000 per person is required at time of booking and will be converted to GBP (the exchange rate will be advised to you) to be offset against the total package price in GBP. This deposit will secure your place on the tour. Your booking will not be confirmed until the Signed Booking Form is returned and the deposit paid.

Second Deposit:

The second deposit of AUD\$5,000 per person is due by April 10, 2016. This deposit will be converted to GBP and remitted to our UK partner for payment. You will be advised of the bank exchange rate used for this transfer.

Final Deposit:

The final payment is due by May 10, 2016. The final payment will be for the full price of the tour in GBP less the deposits paid (first and second) and converted to AUD based on the best bank rate of the day. No refunds are available after the final payment date.

No refunds, under any circumstances, are available after the April 10, 2016.

Payment Method:

Amounts may be paid by bank transfer to our nominated bank trust account in AUD\$. This will be converted to GBP at the prevailing rate and remitted to our Scottish partner for payment of requisite deposits.

Credit cards may be used however a surcharge will be applied depending on the type of card used
– VISA/MC – 3.5%, AMEX/DINERS – 4.5%

Terms and Conditions

INFORMATION

The tour you are booking with GOLFSelect is a customized tour to suit your group and, as such, our procedures and deposit policies vary from other tour operators. The following information will be required to confirm all aspects of your golfing package.

Full name and mailing address of each member of the group. (Including sex, as some clubs in the British Isles restricts days and times ladies may play).

A letter of introduction from each member of the group's home golf club stating handicap and they are in good standing within the club or a copy of your handicap card.

To secure the reservation and place the tour into operation you must complete the booking form and forward the appropriate deposit as outlined above. Deposit amounts will vary depending on the services you have requested. Once your deposit is received your tour will be placed into operation. Deposits are used to secure golf, transport and accommodations and are therefore **non-refundable**. Final payment of the balance due on the tour must be received by GOLFSelect no less than 120 days before the scheduled tour commences. Until then, the total price of the tour is not fully guaranteed. Payment can be made by the following credit cards – Visa or MasterCard, American Express or Diners Club (surcharges apply for all credit cards), personal or company cheque and also bank transfer.

BOOKING CONFIRMATION AND DEPOSIT

Any individual who makes the booking for this trip is responsible for all payments made to GOLFSelect in accordance with the payment schedule listed above.. It will be the responsibility of each individual person making the payment arrangements to ensure they understand both the deposit and cancellations terms and conditions as laid out by GOLFSelect.

CANCELLATIONS

Notification of cancellation must be forwarded to GOLFSelect in writing or by email as soon as possible.

The following is a schedule of charges incurred by the client if for any reason they decide to cancel the tour, 366 and + days prior to the commencement of the tour, loss of initial deposit.

365 – 121 days prior to the commencement of the tour, loss of any deposits paid to date.

LAND TRANSFERS

The itinerary includes coach transport from the point of arrival until departure date unless specified otherwise. All motoring and drivers expenses are included in the price of the tour.

HOTELS

It is the policy of GOLFSelect to use hotels that have a 3, 4 or 5 star rating. All quotations are based on rooms with private bath/shower at the hotels requested. Should any hotel not be available after your quotation, an alternative of similar standard will be offered. Superior and De-luxe rooms are available for a supplementary charge in most hotels.

UNUSED TOUR SERVICES

Tour services included in the tour packages, which are not used, are non-refundable. No refund will be made for unused hotel accommodations, tee times or any other service due to flight delays or unscheduled changes or for any other reason.

TOUR DOCUMENTS

Tour documents will be sent to you approximately 3 weeks prior to your departure date with all relevant documentation therein.

HANDICAP CARD OR CERTIFICATE

GOLFSelect stipulates that all clients must carry with them a current handicap or a general letter of introduction from their home club. Failure to do so may result in access being denied at a number of the clubs. This can be provided to GOLFSelect ahead of the tour.

CADDIES/ PULL BUGGIES

We have included, in our packages, a forecaddie per group as well as a pull buggy. We have found, with experience, that a forecaddie provides an invaluable source of information on where to hit (and where not to) as well as assisting with reading putts.

If you require a dedicated caddy for you this can also be arranged ahead of time. Please advise us on booking if they are required. Caddy fees are to be paid by the client directly to the caddy or caddy master on the day of play and are not the responsibility of GOLFSelect.. Please note that caddies are not directly employed by the respective golf clubs and it is the caddy's responsibility to arrive at the allotted time and as such no responsibility is accepted by GOLFSelect. Gratuities are not included in the caddy fees and are to be paid separately by each individual golfer.

MEET AND GREET

You will be met by a representative of GOLFSelect upon arrival on the first day of the trip, subject to arrival flight times. You will be given a tour briefing at the airport or first night hotel. While travelling you will also have the backup facilities of our Ireland/Scotland offices for any help or advice you may require.

BAGGAGE
