## About the tour...

Experience the best of golf in Scotland and the thrill of the final two days at the 2018 Open Championship at Carnoustie. Combining golf on the best courses in Scotland (including Ballot tee times on the Old Course at St Andrews) the trip promises to be highly memorable.

The trip commences in the historic town of St Andrews where you will stay for 4 nights (less than 200 metres from the first tee of the Old course) and experience all that this famous region has to offer.



Carnoustie Golf Links, Carnoustie, Scotland

The first 3 days of golf provide a 'wow' factor like no other - St Andrews New Course, St Andrews Old Course (ballot) and the spectacular Kingsbarns.

Apart from the world-class golf, the charm of St Andrews cannot be underestimated and you will find yourself immersed in the history of golf from over the last 700 years.

From St Andrews, we will head north to the charming town of Inverness for 4 nights, with its breathtaking scenery and famous lochs. Golf in the Scottish Highlands is an incredible experience, and you will be dazzled by the links at Nairn, Castle Stuart and the highly regarded and very popular Royal Dornoch.

Following your time in Inverness, you head back towards the North Sea to the township of Aberdeen, which will be our base for the final 5 nights. Golf at Trump International, Royal Aberdeen and the magnificent Cruden Bay will set you up for the last two days of the Open Championship at Carnoustie where the winner will receive the famous Claret Jug.

Carnoustie is widely regarded as one of the toughest courses on The Open Rota. Most golfers will recall Jean van de Velde's epic loss of the 1999 Open, where he famously took on the 'Barry Burn', capitulating with a triple bogey 7 on the 72nd hole to scrape his way into a play-off, won by Paul Lawrie. The 2018 Open is sure to provide its fair share of thrills.

This memorable trip finishes with a farewell dinner in Aberdeen where we will recount stories of "what could have been", "what was" and "what will be" and departure is on the morning on July 23, 2018. Of course you may choose to extend your trip beyond this time where we can certainly organise further golf and accommodation arrangements on your behalf.

### **Tuesday 10<sup>th</sup> July 2018**

**Arrival into Edinburgh International Airport. Transfer to Hotel du Vin in St Andrews for check-in.**

**GOLF : Free day - sightseeing day (golf available if desired)**



On arrival in Edinburgh you will meet the team from GOLFSelect. There will be a group transfer to Hotel du Vin, St Andrews. Spend the afternoon exploring the historic township of St Andrews. Now over 100 years old, the New Course at St Andrews is probably the oldest "new" course in the world. Opened in April 1895, the course was built in response to increasing demand for golf at St Andrews, both from locals and visitors.

Upon opening in 2000, Kingsbarns Golf Links immediately established itself as one of the world's must-play links courses. Since 2001, Kingsbarns has co-hosted the annual European Tour's elite Dunhill Links Championship along with the Old Course and Carnoustie.

Its impressive reputation is based on a combination of playability, dramatic seaside location, classic links turf and staff dedicated to personal service. Sir Michael Bonallack, Past Captain of the R&A said of Kingsbarns, "Mere words cannot convey just how extraordinary the place is. It must be seen to be believed. And once seen, it will never be forgotten".

**Friday 13<sup>th</sup> July 2018**

**GOLF : The Old Course St Andrews (*Rated 3 in the World – GOLF Mag USA*)**

The Old Course at St Andrews is the oldest and most iconic golf course in the world – and a must for all avid golfers. It is a destination like no other and the pilgrimage should be made at least once in a golfer's lifetime. The Swilcan Bridge and Hell Bunker are recognized across the globe. This is where it all started and it is undoubtedly the Home of Golf.



The layout of the Old Course is unique and challenging and the sense of history is overwhelming. To tread the turf of St Andrews, where in the 13th century shepherds played a form of golf, is a marvellous experience. The course is known for its 112 bunkers including one of the most famous in golf, the Road Hole bunker at the 17th hole. A peculiar feature of the layout of the Old Course is the double greens where the outward and inward holes are cut on the same putting surface. These large greens can mean that golfers may be faced with putts of almost 100 yards.

To play a round of golf here is an unbelievably special and something you will remember for a lifetime.

In a mansion dating from 1786, this hotel and conference centre on 4 acres of grounds is less than 1 mile from Inverness Castle and 9.4 miles from Inverness airport.

Modern rooms feature flat-screen TVs with premium channels, free Wi-Fi and tea and coffee making equipment.

A leisure club includes an indoor pool and a hot tub, a fitness room, a sauna, a steam room and a spa (surcharge). There's a refined restaurant overlooking spacious gardens, as well as an intimate eatery specializing in Scottish and international cuisines.

There's also a whisky bar, and conference space for up to 480 people.

**Sunday 15<sup>th</sup> July 2018**

**GOLF : Nairn Golf Club**



Ranked number 11 in the list of Top 100 Courses in Scotland 2015 (Golf World Magazine), this Traditional Scottish Golf Links Course was created from a Highland wilderness of gorse and heather, and tests the talents of professional and amateur alike. Founded in 1887, it is now one of the best courses in Scotland, and has hosted a large number of important championships.

Set on the Moray Firth coast in the Highlands of Scotland, Nairn represents traditional Scottish links golf at its very best.

**Monday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2018**

**GOLF : Castle Stuart Golf Links (*Rated 69 in the World – GOLF Mag USA*)**



History and diversity make Scottish golf courses famous throughout the world.

The centrepiece for this Scottish destination golf resort is Castle Stuart Golf Links, a championship links course overlooking the Moray Firth and well-known landmarks that are synonymous with Inverness and the Black Isle – Kessock Bridge and Chanonry Lighthouse perhaps the most notable.

Castle Stuart's goal is to add to the rich fabric of golf in the Scottish Highlands – a fabric made rich by Royal Dornoch, Nairn, Brora, and many other fine Scottish golf clubs.

**Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> July 2018**

**GOLF : Royal Dornoch Golf Club (*Rated 14 in the World – GOLF Mag USA*)**



Royal Dornoch is spellbinding and many golfers from all over the world make the pilgrimage to this natural links at some point in their lives. It is often quoted as one of the must-play courses.

It's the timeless setting that makes Royal Dornoch such a pleasing place to play golf. It's wild, isolated and, at the same time, absolutely beautiful.

Formed in 1877, Royal Dornoch means exceptional standards and always aim to exceed the expectations of frequent visitors and loyal members.



It is not just the Championship course that presents golfers with the challenges of links-land. The second 18 hole course, the Struie, is enjoyable and entertaining for the whole family at a modest green fee, and it can also test the lower handicap player.

### Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> July 2018

**NOTES :** Check out of accommodation. Transfer to Aberdeen (2.5hrs)  
**GOLF :** Trump International Golf Links (*Rated 48 in the World – GOLF Mag USA*)



The championship golf course is a classical Scottish links. The course has a Par of 72 and a maximum length of just over 6767 meters. The golf course follows a classical pattern of two out-and-back loops of nine holes.

All 18 holes thread their way engagingly through the dunes, rising to find views of the sea and coastline, plunging into secluded valleys, offering a sequence of superlative topography, landscape, alternating spaciousness and enclosure, panoramic views, a rich texture of vegetation and wildlife habitats surrounding the golf holes.

The Chester Hotel is a luxury hotel on Aberdeen's Queens Road, located just a 20-minute walk from the city centre. A 19th century listed building with upscale, contemporary rooms.

All rooms feature luxurious rainfall showers, deluxe Egyptian cotton bed linens and Apple TVs. Executive Chef Kevin Dalglish oversees the award-winning fine dining IX Restaurant. There is a stylish bar, a fully equipped gym, and beauty and nail treatment rooms for guests and non-residents. The Chester Hotel provides the ultimate luxury Aberdeen hotel.

**GOLF :** Royal Aberdeen Golf Club



In the league table of golf course antiquity, the Royal Aberdeen Golf Club stands at number six.

Here, at the Balgownie links only a mile from the centre of the city of Aberdeen, is a club founded as the Society of Golfers at Aberdeen in 1780 and one of the most testing and spectacular of all the great links course of Scotland. Today's spectacular layout is largely from the imagination and genius of James Braid. Royal Aberdeen has several claims to fame not the least of them that it was here, in 1783, that the rule which allows only five minutes to look for a lost golf ball was established.

**GOLF : Attend Day 2 of The Open at Carnoustie Golf Links**



Carnoustie has previously hosted The Open on seven occasions. It's not just the strong winds which blow along this exposed stretch of the Angus coast; nor the bunkering, which is perfectly positioned to capture anything less than a top-quality shot; but it is also a very long, narrow golf course that, at 7,421 yards, is the longest of any of the Open venues.

As Sir Michael Bonallack put it, "When the wind is blowing, it is the toughest golf course in Britain. And when it's not blowing, it's probably still the toughest."

Be thrilled by the boundless talent of the world's best players. Be mesmerized by all on offer at golf's most celebrated 'major'!

***On Friday and Sunday you will get to experience all the thrills of the the 147th Open Championship. Golf has been played at Carnoustie since the early 16th century, and in that time, the links have earned a well-deserved reputation as one of the toughest golf destinations in the world.***

**GOLF (PM) : Cruden Bay Golf Club (*Rated 77 in the World – GOLF Mag USA*)**



Cruden Bay is an inspirational golf course, regarded by some as quirky and considered by others as a masterpiece. Either way, this is a thrilling place to play golf because the designers used the original lie of the land to fantastic effect.

Rugged linksland, pebble-dashed with sand dunes as high as three-storey buildings. Elevated tees cut high into the dunes, humped and hollowed fairways bumping their way along to punchbowl greens, nesting in attractive dells. All set against the backdrop of the steely North Sea.

### Initial Deposit and 2nd payment

At the point you are happy with the proposed itinerary we would look to charge you a non-refundable deposit as outlined above.

## Final Payment

## Terms and Conditions

### **INFORMATION**

The tour you are booking with GOLFSelect is a customized tour to suit your group and, as such, our procedures and deposit policies vary from other tour operators. The following information will be required to confirm all aspects of your golfing package.

Full name and mailing address of each member of the group. (Including sex, as some clubs in the British Isles restricts days and times ladies may play).

A letter of introduction from each member of the group's home golf club stating handicap and they are in good standing within the club or a copy of your handicap card.

To secure the reservation and place the tour into operation you must complete the booking form and forward the appropriate deposit as outlined above. Deposit amounts will vary depending on the services you have requested. Once your deposit is received your tour will be placed into operation. Deposits are used to secure golf, transport and accommodations and are therefore **non-refundable**. Final payment of the balance due on the tour must be received by GOLFSelect no less than 120 days before the scheduled tour commences. Until then, the total price of the tour is not fully guaranteed. Payment can be made by the following credit cards – Visa or MasterCard, American Express or Diners Club (surcharges apply for all credit cards), personal or company cheque and also bank transfer.

### **BOOKING CONFIRMATION AND DEPOSIT**

Any individual who makes the booking for this trip is responsible for all payments made to GOLFSelect in accordance with the payment schedule listed above.. It will be the responsibility of each individual person making the payment arrangements to ensure they understand both the deposit and cancellations terms and conditions as laid out by GOLFSelect.

### **CANCELLATIONS**

Notification of cancellation must be forwarded to GOLFSelect in writing or by email as soon as possible. The following is a schedule of charges incurred by the client if for any reason they decide to cancel the tour, 366 and + days prior to the commencement of the tour, loss of initial deposit.  
365 – 121 days prior to the commencement of the tour, loss of any deposits paid to date.  
120 – 0 days prior to the commencement of the tour, total tour cost non-refundable.

If GOLFSelect has any reason to cancel the tour, a full refund will be made including any deposits paid.

### **LAND TRANSFERS**

The itinerary includes coach transport from the point of arrival until departure date unless specified otherwise. All motoring and drivers expenses are included in the price of the tour.

### **HOTELS**

It is the policy of GOLFSelect to use hotels that have a 4 or 5 star rating. All quotations are based on rooms with private bath/shower at the hotels requested. Should any hotel not be available after your quotation, an alternative of similar standard will be offered. Superior and De-luxe rooms are available for a supplementary charge in most hotels.

### **UNUSED TOUR SERVICES**

Tour services included in the tour packages, which are not used, are non-refundable. No refund will be made for unused hotel accommodations, tee times or any other service due to flight delays or unscheduled changes or for any other reason.

### **TOUR DOCUMENTS**

Tour documents will be sent to you approximately 3 weeks prior to your departure date with all relevant documentation therein.

### **HANDICAP CARD OR CERTIFICATE**

GOLFSelect stipulates that all clients must carry with them a current handicap or a general letter of introduction from their home club. Failure to do so may result in access being denied at a number of the clubs. This can be provided to GOLFSelect ahead of the tour.

### **CADDIES/ PULL BUGGIES**

We have included, in our packages, a forecaddie per group as well as a pull buggy. We have found, with experience, that a forecaddie provides an invaluable source of information on where to hit (and where not to) as well as assisting with reading putts.

If you require a dedicated caddy for you this can also be arranged ahead of time. Please advise us on booking if they are required. Caddy fees are to be paid by the client directly to the caddy or caddy master on the day of play and are not the responsibility of GOLFSelect.. Please note that caddies are not directly employed by the respective golf clubs and it is the caddie's responsibility to arrive at the allotted time and as such no responsibility is accepted by GOLFSelect. Gratuities are not included in the caddy fees and are to be paid separately by each individual golfer.



## **Terms and Conditions**

### **MEET AND GREET**

You will be met by a representative of GOLFSelect upon arrival on the first day of the trip, subject to arrival flight times. You will be given a tour briefing at the airport or first night hotel. While travelling you will also have the backup facilities of our Ireland/Scotland offices for any help or advice you may require.
